**An exhibition of Berlin contemporary artists
A BERGHAIN and BOROS collaboration**

Berghain and the Boros Foundation present **STUDIO BERLIN**, an exhibition of works from over 100 contemporary artists who live and work in Berlin. The show features national and international artworks in the fields of photography, sculpture, painting, video, sound, performance and installation. From September 9 to the end of December 2020. The exhibition is organized by the Boros Foundation and will take place in **Berghain, Panorama Bar, Säule and Halle.**

The focus of the exhibition is the studio as a space for contemplation and production. The artists' studios are venues for discussion, reflection, translation, analysis, and conceptual thinking. STUDIO BERLIN serves as a glimpse and exploration of the artists' current situation, documenting their point of view.

Berlin has the highest density of studios and artists' workshops in Europe, with artists from all over the world moving to the German capital. In Spring 2020 everything changed; planned exhibitions and art fairs were cancelled or postponed, galleries and museums closed and larger projects could not be realized. Similarly, clubs and nightlife in Berlin came to a sudden halt. The collaboration between Boros and Berghain emerged from this situation to offer Berlin-based artists a public platform to present their work and create a site for current dialogue.

The exhibition reflects a spectrum of perspectives from up-and-coming artists and established artists. The network of exhibiting artists was selected independently of their galleries and remains open throughout the exhibition to continuously integrate new works.

Berghain is a techno club in the Berlin district of Friedrichshain-Kreuzberg. The exhibition works will be displayed alongside the club's permanent collection over an area of 3500 square meters.
